



NDIS Funding Justification Guide: LusioMATE (Plan Year 2026-27)

Provider: Lusio Rehab (NDIS Provider No. 4050026071)

Product Cost: \$1,490 (One-off purchase, below the low-cost Assistive Technology threshold)

Annual Software Licence: \$399/year. This covers the integrated clinical dashboard access, unlimited client support, mandatory software updates, and the ongoing release of new therapeutic features to guarantee lifetime value and continuous remote monitoring capabilities.

1. Executive Summary & Clinical Governance

LusioMATE is a prescribed, wearable assistive technology system consisting of physical movement sensors and integrated digital interfaces. It is utilised under the strict direction of a registered Allied Health professional (e.g., Occupational Therapist, Physiotherapist or exercise Physiologist) to facilitate home-based completion of prescribed therapeutic movement programmes.

Core Plan Alignment:

- **Disability-Related Functional Need:** Directly addresses motor-control deficits, muscle weakness, and restricted range of movement.
- **Value for Money:** The automated capturing of movement data allows clinicians to remotely monitor progress and adjust programmes, significantly reducing the necessity for high-frequency, in-person therapy sessions.
- **Capacity Building:** Promotes independent daily living skills by bridging the gap between face-to-face clinical interventions.

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3. Assistive Technology Setup, Customisation & Mentoring Codes

To ensure successful deployment, clinical compliance, and participant independence without drawing from standard therapy delivery hours, the 2026-27 schedule offers dedicated capacity-building AT lines:

- 15_047_0135_1_3 — Selection or Manufacture of Individualised Technology - Direct Service** (National Rate: **\$193.99/hr**)
 - Application:* Utilised by the supervising therapist for the initial clinical onboarding, physical calibration of the sensors, and defining customised movement thresholds tailored to the participant's physical limitations.
- 15_300_0103_1_3 — Assistive Technology Mentoring** (National Rate: **\$110.44/hr**)
 - Application:* Utilised for direct participant training to build independence in applying the sensors, launching the biofeedback application interface, and self-managing their home programme between reviews.

Subscription Service Alignment: In accordance with standard NDIS claiming provisions, the \$399 annual licence operates on a formal subscription model of payment, where the participant secures ongoing access to the digital support interface and integrated clinical monitoring for the duration of the subscription period. As dictated by NDIS rules, this subscription framework is applied exclusively to the delivery of eligible **Consumables (Support Category 03)** or **Assistive Technology (Support Category 05)** lines, funding the mandatory delivery of software compliance updates, live diagnostic reporting, and automated dashboard functionality to yield continuous lifetime value.
